



Call for tenders

MASTER – 2025

To promote access for students to master's programs, the institute MarMaRa offers Scholarships grants for a period of **up to 6 months**. The students will work **in one of the research team** associated to the institute and conduct a scientific project related to the fields of MarMaRa.

General eligibility criteria and evaluation rules:

- A team can apply a **maximum of two times to the same call** and the team leader will be asked to rank the applications.
- For TAGC members (laboratory not operating in teams) only four applications for the whole laboratory are accepted for each call session.
- In case of two applications from the same team for the same call, the applications ranked second will be evaluated by the scientific committee according to the budget available.
- Masters' internships and PhD students must only be funded by the dedicated calls ("Master" "End of thesis").

Specific eligibility criteria:

- Applicants should be in the **2nd year of his/her Master**.
- Applicants should be working in one of the **MarMaRa's research affiliated team**.
- To be eligible a significant proportion (at least half) of the team members (students, non-permanent, permanent staff) must have been involved in the institute's activities¹ during the last academic year. If not, you commit to participate for the current academic year.

Evaluation:

The Scientific committee of MarMaRa will evaluate and select the candidates. The evaluation criteria will be the academic results and the CV.

- CV
